## Parents as Partners Experimenting with Textures

### Materials

- Materials of various textures, sandpaper, old carpeting, fabric, cotton balls, fun fur and so on
- Metal lids from frozen juice cans
- Glue
- Magnets

### Directions

- Cut the various materials you have gathered into a round shape that will fit the frozen-juice can lids
- Glue the material into the lid
- Younger toddlers will enjoy simply feeling the textures
- Magnets glued in the back of the lids will allow your child to play with them on the refrigerator or on a cookie sheet placed on the tray of her highchair
- For older children, make two sets and have them sort the lids by matching the materials or sorting by texture. Have fun!
