



COVID-19 Parent Agreement and What to Expect

During this difficult and stressful time, we at the Escondido Community Child Development Center want you to know that we value the safety and wellbeing of you and your child(ren). For this reason, we ask that you take time to read through the following statements we have put into place to keep everyone healthy and safe:

- If you meet any of the following criteria, please do not visit or pick-up/drop-off a child at the Center.
 - ▲ Have underlying health conditions, including those with compromised immune systems or respiratory conditions
 - ▲ Have symptoms of COVID-19 (fever, cough, shortness of breath)
 - ▲ Have been in contact with someone with COVID-19 in the last 14 days or
 - ▲ Have returned from travel to areas with community spread of COVID-19 **as defined by the CDC** in the last 14 days
- Parents/guardians must wear a mask during pick up, drop off, and practice social distancing.
- The same person is to pick up or drop off a child(ren) as much as possible. **If someone other than parent is dropping off, they have to be able to answer our screening questions.**
- At this time parents/guardians are not allowed in the Center. When picking up or dropping off a child(ren), please wait outside and a teacher/staff person will assist you. There will be markers to line up on that are 6 feet apart. If all markers are taken, please stay in your car. Please know that drop off may take longer than usual.
- If your child becomes ill while at the Center, you will be asked to pick-up your child within one hour of staff contacting you. Please have plans in place to ensure you or a designated person is available (on the emergency card) if this should occur.
- Bring only one change of clothes to the Center. Bring whole pack of unopened diapers. Do not bring other personal items to the Center. All personal belongings will be kept in child's individual cubby.
- Please review your enrollment information to ensure we have your current contact information as well as emergency contact information. Please complete the emergency contact information at the bottom of this agreement.
- Your child will receive a daily health check before being admitted into the center. They will have their temperature taken with a non-touch thermometer and you will be asked the following questions. Temperatures of 100.0 degrees cannot stay and need to remain off the center for 72 hours fever free. If you have answered yes to any of these questions, you child will not be able to go into the center. If they pass daily health check, staff member will sign them in and take them to their classroom.
 - Have you or anyone in your family had any of the following symptoms within the last 14 days?
 - Sore throat, persistent cough, trouble breathing, gastrointestinal issues, fever, chills, profuse sweating?
 - Have you or your child experienced any of the symptoms currently?
 - Have you had any contact with someone with these symptoms or someone with a confirmed COVID-19 diagnosis in the last 14 days?
 - Have you traveled outside the United States and where to in the last 21 days?
 - Supervisors may determine the risk of the health of each individual based on health check, temperature, symptoms, travel.

- Group sizes will be no larger than 10 children.
- There will be no co-mingling of groups inside or outside.
- There will be designated staff for each group.
- Events and field trips will be cancelled until further notice.
- The hours of operation are 7:30am-3:30pm, to ensure thorough disinfecting. Late fees apply to late pick ups past 3:30pm (see Parent Handbook).
- Cleaning and disinfecting will be done throughout the day, especially if anything is shared and high touch items such as light switches. Playground structures and equipment will be disinfected in between group uses.
- Many signs will be posted at the front office, please read them.
- Staff will be wearing masks.
- Children under 2 are not advised to wear a mask. It is very difficult for young children to wear them; however, they can be encouraged if parent wants child to try to wear a mask.
- We will no longer have family style mealtime.
- Children will be frequently washing hands as well as using hand sanitizers (monitored by teachers) before and after activities.
- If child is sick, or sent home with a fever, they may return when they have been SYMPTOM FREE for 72 hours.
- Do not give your child a fever reducer (Tylenol) before coming to the center.
- Children will get a bag of materials every day, so they are not sharing many items.
- We are not allowing visitors, unless it is necessary to the operation of the facility.
- Some soft items, dramatic play items, sand boxes will not be available to the children.
- Call center by 9am if absent.
- ECCDC will do our best to prevent the contamination and spread of COVID-19, understand there is always a risk of obtaining disease when not quarantined. Also, understand the possibility of us having to close down your child's classroom or entire site if there are confirmed cases. Duration will depend on guidance from the Health Department. We will communicate and send notifications through Learning Genie and engage in Distance Learning during closure.
